First the egg gets a tail.

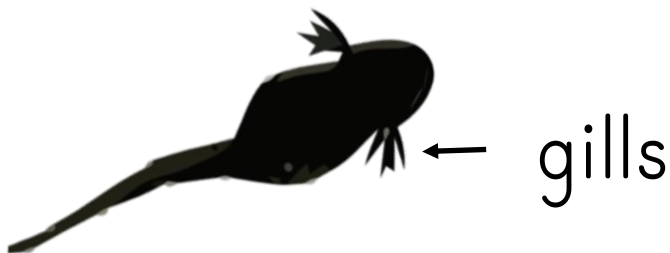
Can you see the long tail?

gills.



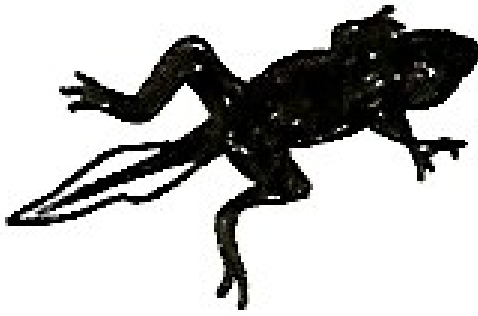
At six weeks, the tadpole gets lungs so that it can breathe like we do.
